Try

```
Dim MyDur As String
MyDur = FileSystem.CurDir
Dim FileToSaveAs As String
RichTextBox1.Copy()

If My.Computer.Clipboard.ContainsImage Then
    PictureBox2.Image = My.Computer.Clipboard.GetImage
Else
    MsgBox("Clipboard does not contain an image", MsgBoxStyle.Exclamation And
MsgBoxStyle.OkOnly)
End If

SaveFileDialog1.DefaultExt = ".jpg"
SaveFileDialog1.Filter = "JPG (*.jpg)|*.jpg|All files (*.*)|*.*"
SaveFileDialog1.InitialDirectory = MyDur
SaveFileDialog1.ShowDialog()
FileToSaveAs = SaveFileDialog1.FileName
PictureBox1.Image.Save(FileToSaveAs,
System.Drawing.Imaging.ImageFormat.Jpeg)
